- SN LABS may avail library, Internet, and computational facilities at OMEGA COLLEGE OF PHARMACY,.
 - j) In any of the activities mentioned above, wherever financial aspects are involved, the amount, payment conditions, etc. would be spelled out clearly before starting the activity.

ARTICLE-III: SHARING OF FACILITIES

- a) **Both the parties** shall make provisions to share their respective important R&D facilities to promote academic and research interaction in the areas of cooperation.
- b) **Both the parties**. shall permit the sharing of software and other materials and components developed in-house in the areas of cooperation, if permissible within the rules governing the two institutions. However, responsibility for the safety of software and other materials during the exchangewill rest on the respective Head of the academic department/section.
- c) **Both the parties**. shall provide access to the library facilities to scientists, members of faculty, and students as per the prevailing rules and norms in the respective institutes.

ARTICLE-IV: CO-ORDINATION OF THE PROGRAMME INCLUDING FINANCIAL

ARRANGEMENTS

a) The collaborative program between Both the parties shall be coordinated by a



coordination committee appointed by the Directors of both the Institutes.

b) Financial arrangements for each specific collaboration will be decided on a case-to-case basis and brought on record in each case after due approval from the heads of both Institutions.

ARTICLE-V: EFFECTIVE DATE AND DURATION OF MOU

- a) This MOU shall be effective from the date of its approval by competent authorities at both ends.
- b) The duration of the MOU shall be for 5 years from the effective date.
- c) During its tenancy, the MOU may be extended or terminated by a prior notice of notless than six months by either party. However, termination of the MOU will not in any manner affect the interests of the students/faculty/scientists who have been admitted to pursue a program under the MOU.
- **d)** Any clause or article of the MOU may be modified or amended by mutual agreement of Both the parties

e) ARTICLE-VI: IPR

Rights regarding publications, patents, royalty, ownership of software/design/product developed, etc. under the scope of this MOU, shall be decided by the two parties by mutual consent.

ARTICLE-VII: CONFIDENTIALITY

During the tenure of the MOU Both the parties will maintain strict confidentiality and prevent disclosure of all the information and data exchanged under the scope of this MOU for any purpose other than per this MOU

Both the parties shall bind their respective personnel who come into possession or knowledge of any confidential information not to disclose the same to third parties without the written approval of the disclosing party or use such confidential information for any use other than intended under this agreement or PROJECTS.



Further Both the parties shall put in place adequate and reasonable measures to keep and store confidential information secure to prevent any unauthorized use.

• CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION shall mean any proprietary information, data, or facts belonging to PARTIES collectively or severally, disclosed by the disclosing party under this agreement or any subsequent agreement. Whether in writing, verbal, or electronically, irrespective of the medium in which such information is stored, which is marked confidential or with any other words having similar meaning by the disclosing party, or specifically agreed to be kept confidential by the parties, or declared or identified so by the disclosing party before such disclosure or during the discussions.
